- We will Involve our staff in maintaining our environmental management system, identifying areas for improvement, reviewing our performance and providing feedback on initiatives and opportunities for improvement
- All our staff will be selected, trained and developed to carry out their duties safely, competently and with due care for the environment
- We will take opportunities to achieve continual improvement of the Environmental Management System to enhance environmental performance
- We will implement measures to protect the environment, including prevention of pollution, where reasonably practicable
- We will Keep under review all our business operations, in order to identify and minimise environmental impacts
- We will identify steps to reduce disturbance to sensitive seabed communities and preserve biodiversity as far as possible
- We will set environmental objectives, monitor progress in achieving these and report results to the Board on a regular basis
